



EMERGENCY LIGHTING & EXIT SIGN INSPECTION

When a power failure or fire occurs, the safety of your employees and customers is essential. Battery powered emergency lighting, when provided, require that a functional test be conducted on thirty-day intervals and a 1-½ hour duration test be conducted annually. At the time of an emergency, have peace of mind that your lights will work and guide your employees and customers to safety. We will perform your monthly and annual testing with a Tri State Fire Protection certified emergency light technician. We will provide you with the required reporting to meet your local, state and federal requirements. The proper maintenance of your lighting will extend your battery life and reduce energy costs.



The Inspection Will Include:

1. Inspect the lighting system to determine whether it is in service and in satisfactory condition in accordance with NFPA standards.
2. Conduct a complete test of the lighting system to ensure it will illuminate a minimum of 90 minutes (OSHA, NFPA and NEC minimum standards).
3. Adjust the PC board float voltage. This will ensure extended life of the batteries and other key components.
4. Inspect all bulbs and lamp heads to ensure they are operational and meet lighting requirements.
5. Clean all battery terminals and leads.
6. Survey the emergency lights and exit signs for proper placement.
7. Check the energy efficiencies of the bulbs and lamps.
8. Tag or label devices as required and perform all required record keeping.
9. Identify potentially detrimental site conditions that could compromise the performance of mechanical and/or electronic components of the system.
10. Compile a complete report of the inspection, explaining any deficiencies and recommending corrective action to be taken in accordance with recognized codes for care and maintenance.
